Your statement should address the theoretical framework of the dissertation, its specific aims, methodologies (how you will conduct the research), originality, and the significance and contribution of the project to your field. Fellowship committees place a **strong** emphasis on this statement. When writing your statement, keep in mind that it should be written with an interdisciplinary faculty review panel in mind; i.e., reviewers would NOT necessarily be familiar with the technical vocabulary of your specific field. (**Please DO NOT attach a dissertation prospectus**). Any additional materials included will not be presented to the screening committee.
